General Notes:

- The final exam grade is 15% of the final grade or 20% of the final grade for AP and Honors courses.
- Final exams must be taken by each student in each class to earn the class credit towards graduation.
- All students are expected to be in class during the entire finals period. All teachers are expected to begin the final at the start time according to the schedule and cannot administer finals early unless approved by the principal or as part of a student's IEP.
- Students absent for final exams will only be approved for early or make up exams if the absence is excused (see Student Handbook). If the absence is not excused, students will not receive greater than 70% for the exam grade, even if taken early. Parents must contact the school Principal or Assistant Principal to share the absence and make arrangements for make-up exams.

Students with Disabilities (SWD) Notes:

- Resource teachers will administer exams for resource courses the week prior to this exam schedule.
- On exam day the general education teachers will send all SWD who plan on testing in resource to their respective resource teachers as soon as they have finished with the review for the course.
- If a SWD is finished testing during the exam period, the teachers will allow them to report to their resource teachers upon request to finish other exams.

What if a student does not take the Spring final exams?

Students will be given an incomplete and NOT earn credit for the course if they do not take the final exam. This can affect athletic eligibility and will be the responsibility of the student and parent to contact the Principal to make arrangements to make up final exams.
